

The multiple image photograph on this month's cover shows a welded metal sculpting by Carley Craig. Most of us know Carley as a painter, but a few years ago she embarked on a third career: first she was a costume designer on the west coast, then a painter, and now she is a sculptor of metals. To prepare for her new art form, she studied at Georgia State University and at the Atlanta School of Art. Since she is particularly interested in dance and works out regularly with the Atlanta Contemporary Dance Group, many of her pieces express dance movements. The size of this piece, "Introspection," is about four by four and a half feet. It will be used in the March performance of the Atlanta Dance Group. The sculpting has moving parts which will be activated by touch.
